SAN FRANCISCO LABOR COUNCIL ENDORSES CONNIE CHAN FOR CONGRESS

San Francisco - Connie Chan has been endorsed by the San Francisco Labor Council (SFLC) for her campaign to succeed Speaker Emerita Nancy Pelosi in California Congressional District 11. SFLC is the local body of the AFL-CIO. Over 150 unions are affiliated with the SFLC, representing more than 100,000 union members and their families.
